In his two years there, he revitalized the middle school Theatre department, tripling enrollment and expanding it from one Beginning and one Advanced Theatre class to a full-time, 5-class course within two years, culminating in three sold-out performances and an unexpected encore show. He cannot wait to share his knowledge and expertise with the teens at HoopEd!

Students will develop foundational theater skills by participating in a variety of ensemble-building activities, improvisation exercises, and performance opportunities, in order to improve their communication, confidence, stage presence.
